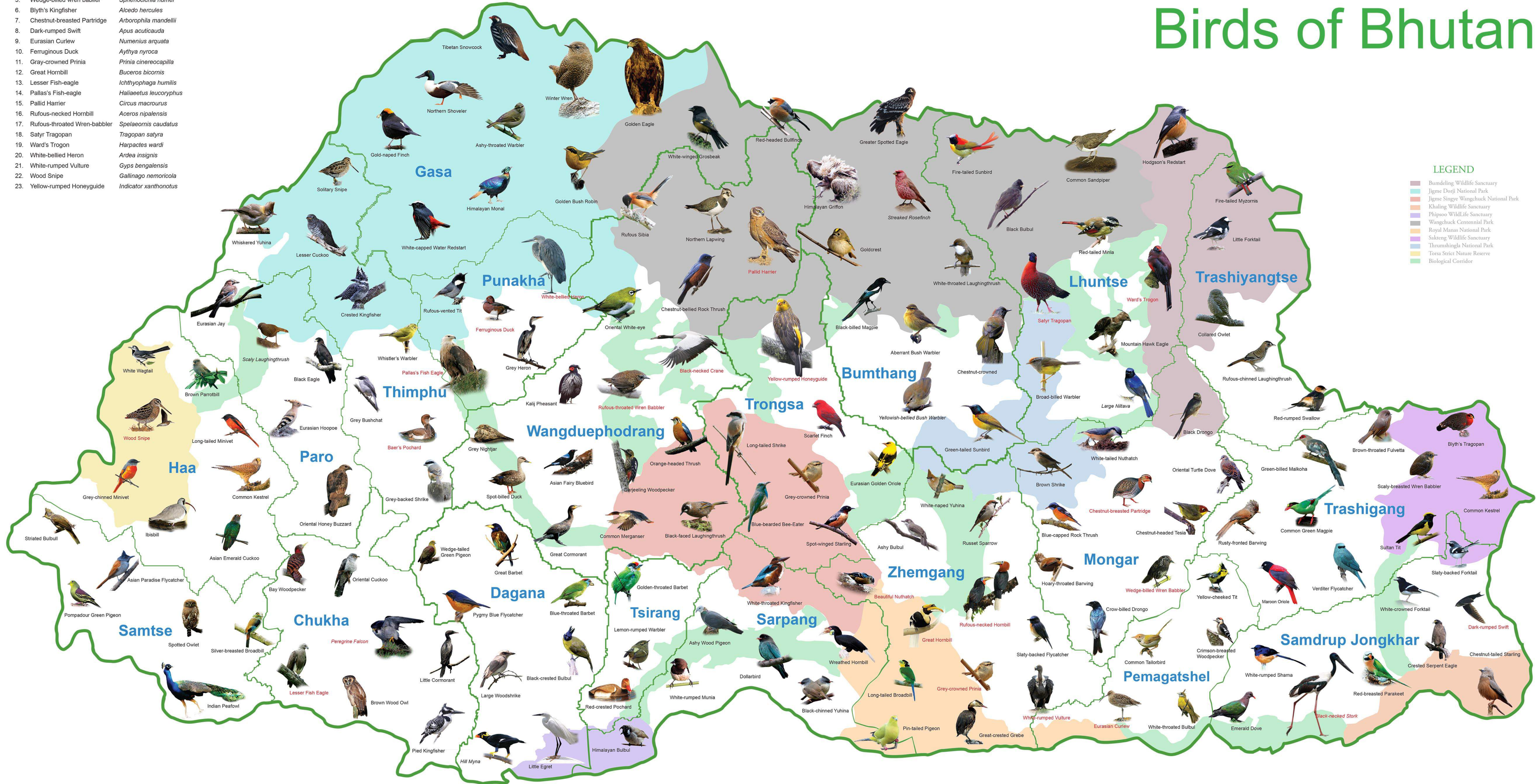

Birds of Bhutan



About 770 species of birds have been found in Bhutan, one of the highest species densities in the world. Recognized as one of the 221 global endemic bird areas, around 50 species of the known birds are winter migrants while more than 16 species are categorized as vulnerable. Additionally, ten species of birds are in danger of extinction, including the Imperial Heron (White-bellied Heron), which is one of the 50 rarest birds in the world. Many more species are yet to be discovered.
